Trip to Russia to take a 7D cosmonaut training OR a trip to Japan to see the rocket carrying the experiment take off. A trip to Washington Dc, USA & the Zero-G flight Experience. A chance to see their experiments performed in space & Streamed live on You Tube. Opportunity to get school recognized on a global level. The representative had visited our school to interact with the students, explained the competition in detail through an Audio Visual Presentation and cleared students’ queries.Lets wait to watch them upload an idea in the “YouTube Space Lab.”
