Well, understanding the use of resources for ideas was highlighted in a language workshop conducted by the English teachers for grades 5 & 6. A PPT for Literacy Elements was shown to the students. The sound effects and visual aids created a virtual treat to hone their creative writing skills.

The examples of conflicts like Man vs Man, Man vs Nature, Man vs Technology etc. gave the children an insight into the various elements of story writing. The PPT also helped the students to distinguish between the protagonists and the antagonists. This triggered ideas which aided them to develop a plot for their story as their follow up activity in their classes.

The story starters given to them were...Rocket to the Mysterious Planet and Experiences of being Invisible at home or at school.

They thoroughly enjoyed getting *invisible* and playing tricks on paper to fool their teachers, friends and parents. Their smiles while writing the stories displayed the fun they had!

Science fiction, one of the most popular titles among children enhanced their skills to write about aliens and mysterious experiences during their journey to a different land. This activity was a great experience to display their creative writing abilities.
