On 1st Feb.2012 , students of RBK International visited our school to create awareness on the project 'Operation Smile' a non-profit organization that provides reconstructive surgery to treat facial deformities such as cleft lip and palates of children and young adults .The students presented a PPT about how children who are born with a cleft lip are often unable to eat, speak, or smile. In most families these children are shunned and rejected. And in many cases, their parents can't afford to give them the required surgeries they need to lead a normal life.

The students of RBK pointed out that our students could also help out in various ways to collect funds for this NGO.

Operation Smile is more than an NGO. It is a mobilized force of medical professionals who provide safe and effective reconstructive surgery to the affected children bringing back a smile into their lives.
